HOW TO OBTAIN THE GRANT: THREE SIMPLE STEPS

1. **Step 1.** Contact us (nicole.ferber@sbg.ac.at) and fill in the registration form available on the Web site (<http://www.spatialcitizenship.org/>). This provides us with your contact data (name, organisation, email, phone number), allowing us to send you the *confirmation of your provisional registration* that you need to enclose in your grant application form at your National Agency.
2. **Step 2.** Contact your own National Agency to obtain a grant application form. Please note that you need to submit your application by **14th September 2013**. National Agency contact details can be found at: http://ec.europa.eu/education/programmes/llp/national_en.html
3. **Step 3.** Send your ***grant application form*** to your National Agency along with the *confirmation of your provisional registration* before 14th September 2013.

Your National Agency will inform you if you have been awarded a grant after analysing all applications received and you should inform us immediately of the outcome. In general, there are very good chances of you receiving the grant! Please don't forget that the completion and the submission of the application form is a straight forward process for getting full financial support to attend these seminars but you need to act as soon as possible.

The workshop is based on innovative approaches, resources and information to encourage teaching with ICT and location-based media.
